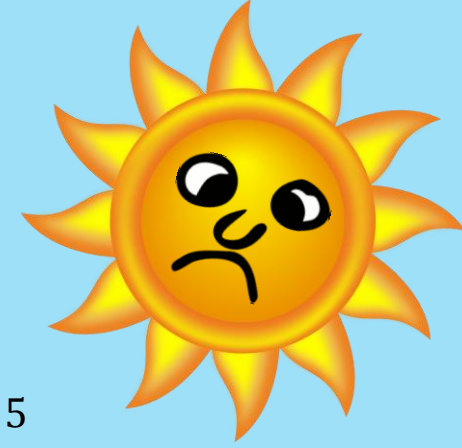

- Texting takes your eyes off the road for an average of 5 seconds, **that's enough time to travel the length of a football field at 55mph**
- Texting while driving can delay your reaction **as much as a drunk driver.**



It is against the law!



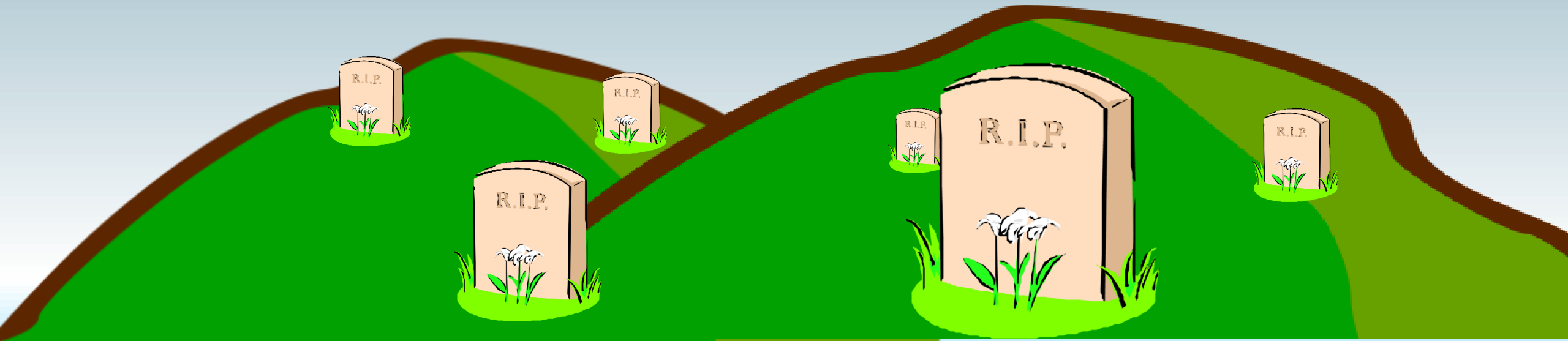
-The minimum fine for texting or using a handheld phone is **\$148** dollars

-Additional tickets increase to **\$256** dollars

-Adults may talk on the phones while driving but are not permitted to hold a cellphone while driving.

Statistics

- In 2015, **3,477** people were killed in motor vehicle crashes involving distracted drivers.
- Cellphones were a major factor in the crashes
- Your chances of being in a car accident increase by **400%** while using a cellphone
